✎ In most of the cases, publications arose from these meetings.

**THE SERIES ‘OPIFICIO DI LINGUA E LETTERATURA LATINA’ (2015-2018)**

• The *Opifici* took place for a limited period, since the beginnings of the project, in 2015, till the end of 2018. This series of seminars was intended as a training and formative moment for PLATINUM and its team, as seminars and lessons of the *Opificio* were given by highly-ranked specialists in several fields of classics. This supported the training of PLATINUM's post-docs and younger scholars, up to when they actually became proper specialists in the peculiar field of Latin texts on papyrus, which also explains the fact that, if the *Opifici – II.b* (= the training series) ended, the *Works in Progress – II.c* (= the occasion of discussion among the team-members) kept going on longer.

**THE SERIES ‘PLATINUM’S WORKS IN PROGRESS’ (2016-2021)**

- The seminars of the series *Works in Progress* were intended as a moment of collective (and public) discussion of PLATINUM’s research team – at least that part of the team established in Naples –, and they represented an important base for the researches of each scholar of the team.
- Speakers of this series mainly were PLATINUM’s post-docs and PLATINUM’s younger grantees. In fact, even younger scholars at the very beginnings of their academic path were involved as speakers, which mainly had two benefits as 1. the possibility of discuss their own researches and works was also offered to younger scholars as a formative moment, as the discussion with more experienced researches made them grow up, and, 2. the P.I. could monitorate the work carried on by younger grantees on PLATINUM’s topic assigned to them for research.
- In a few cases, speakers not belonging to PLATINUM’s team gave seminar within this series; in this case, their institutions are indicated.
- These seminars were mainly held by the Department of Humanities of the Univ. Naples ‘Federico II’, and, more specifically, in PLATINUM’s room: PLATINUM’s internal debates had to take place in PLATINUM’s spaces, in order to make PLATINUM’s room a place where to stimulate discussion and growth.
