

## Admission to and Enrolling in the Industrial Bioengineering Programme Frequently Asked Questions

1. what is the access form to the Master's Degree for?

It serves the didactic coordination commission (CCD) to verify the possession of the requisites of the personal preparation and the curricular requisites, that is possession of the degree title, average weight mark higher than 24/30 and certification of knowledge of the English language level B2.

2. I have all the requirements, do I still have to submit the form and documentation?

Yes, of course, it is first of all necessary to assess whether the English certificate in possession is adequate and also the CCD must notify the Student's Office of the names of those who can be enrolled (otherwise the student's id is temporarily blocked).

3. What BSc degree (at least a three-year programme) is acceptable to be enrolled in the MSc course? Students with a degree in Chemical Engineering, Biomedical Engineering or Science and Engineering of Materials obtained at the University of Naples Federico II and in possession of the preparation and curricular requirements, are automatically admitted. Yet they still have to send the above mentioned documentation to the CCD. Students with other academic qualifications, or qualifications obtained at other universities, although in possession of the requirements, MUST still send the documentation to the CCD for the pre-evaluation. Better stay safe than sorry. Send all the relevant documents to the CCD.

4. I have an average grade of less than 24, but I am interested in the course. What can I do?

It is advisable to send the documentation anyway. The commission will evaluate the career and decide on admission, small deviations from 24/30 and having achieved high marks in exams related to Industrial Bioengineering are generally sufficient to have admission to the course.

5. I have a B1 level English proficiency certificate, what can I do?

Those with level B1 can access a supplementary interview, usually carried out before the start of the courses and subsequently on a monthly basis (depending on the number of applicants). In case of a positive evaluation after the interview, the students can enroll (provided that the other requirements are satisfied)

6. I have no certificate of proficiency in the English language. What can I do?

The University Language Center (CLA) provides a Placement test service dedicated to students wishing to enroll in the course. The dates are still to be defined and will be published as soon as possible. Placement tests are usually carried out in mid-September and mid-October.

7. I graduate in September / October / December, can I enroll in the course?

Of course! Registrations are open until December 31st. As soon as the qualification is obtained, fill in the form and submit it to the CCD for the pre-evaluation.

8. I think I will graduate after December, am I still in time to enroll?

In this case, the rules issued by the school apply: you can graduate by March 31st, as long as you have taken exams scheduled for the first semester for a total of 12 ECTS. The procedure for carrying out exams is that of the so-called "token" exams (see the downloads section).
